Commitment to collegiality and proven ability to work within a richly diverse environment are required. Applicants must possess a post-baccalaureate degree (Pharm.D., Ph.D. or equivalent), with post-doctoral or fellowship training. All applications from qualified individuals will be considered, with preference given to applicants with specific expertise in clinical sciences, pharmaceutical sciences, pharmacogenomics, or health policy. The successful candidate will be expected to possess and develop an area of research funded by either of the tri-council funding agencies, teach in the Graduate and Undergraduate programs, and provide service to the Faculty and University. **Position Number: 13795**
