Applications are invited for a Clinical Associate/Full Professor in the Division of Pharmacy Practice. The individual will serve as Director of the PharmD program and will have administrative responsibilities for implementation, management, evaluation, and quality improvement activities for the PharmD program. This is a full-time, rolling term appointment under the Contract Academic Staff: Teaching Agreement, with primarily teaching, administrative and service responsibilities. Scholarly activities are encouraged.

Specific responsibilities include, but are not limited to, providing leadership for the implementation of the Faculty's new PharmD program; overseeing course development and approval processes (Faculty and University bodies); overseeing PharmD program evaluation; teaching; service responsibilities to the Faculty, University and profession.

The successful candidate will have knowledge of current clinical pharmacy practice as well as assessment methodologies. Preference will be given to candidates with a PharmD degree and postdoctoral experience. Applicants with other advanced pharmacy qualifications such as completion of a residency program will also be considered. Applicants must be licensed, or eligible for licensure, by the Alberta College of Pharmacists.

The Faculty of Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences offers one of the strongest pharmacy degree programs in Canada. The Faculty annually admits 130 student pharmacists, and currently has 62 graduate students. The PharmD program will admit 13 students in the first year, increasing to 30 in subsequent years. The University of Alberta has over 38,000 students and was ranked in 2011 by *The Scientist* magazine as one of the top 10 best places to work in academia in non-USA institutions. Excellent opportunities exist for collaborative research with other disciplines within the faculty and university as well as externally.

The University of Alberta is located in Edmonton, a vibrant, cosmopolitan city of 1 million and the provincial capital. This friendly city offers a rich cultural life and diverse recreational opportunities. The campus is located adjacent to one of the largest municipal park systems in North America and is approximately 3.5 hours by car from the Canadian Rocky Mountains.

Applications will be reviewed beginning **January 15, 2012** and will continue until the position is filled. Interested individuals should submit a letter of interest, curriculum vitae, a description of research and teaching interests, and the names and addresses of three referees.
