Tenure track faculty position in Drug Delivery and/or Biotechnology

Candidates must possess a PhD in a related discipline with specialization in **drug delivery or biotechnology** with postdoctoral training or suitable industrial experience.

Candidates are expected to have an outstanding record of research accomplishment and other scholarly activities. Teaching will be expected at both the undergraduate and graduate levels. Excellent opportunities exist for collaborative research with Pharmacy and other University faculty units with expertise in pharmaceutical oncology, drug delivery, metabolism, pharmacokinetics and toxicology.

The Faculty of Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences offers one of the strongest Pharmacy degree programs in Canada. The Faculty has 520 undergraduate and 57 graduate students. The University of Alberta has over 38,000 students and was ranked in 2011 by The Scientist magazine as one of the top 10 best places to work in academia in non-USA institutions.
