### CSPS Formulation Workshop

**Development Strategies and Drug Delivery Considerations** was held on December 9, 2010 at the Faculty of Pharmacy, University of Toronto. Fifty participants from industry and academia attended this all-day workshop and the overwhelming response was for CSPS to hold this workshop again in other parts of the country.

### Spoon-Dosing For Children

The Cornell University Food and Brand Lab study had participants spoon-dose 5 mL of cold medicine on medium and large-sized spoons after a practice pour of exactly 5 mL on a standard teaspoon. Results showed that even after a practice pour participants under-dosed by 8.6% on the medium spoons and overdosed by 11.6% on the large spoons. What is more, participants had above-average confidence that they had poured the correct dosage even when they had not.
